The City Council of the City of Boca Raton will be interviewing applicants to fill vacancies on the following Boards:

BOCA RATON ADVISORY BOARD FOR PEOPLE WITH DISABILITIES

Three vacancies.

Members of this board make recommendations to the City Council regarding issues confronting people with disabilities, and seek to educate the public on such issues.

ELDER AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD

Two vacancies. Must be a resident of the City of Boca Raton.

The Elder Affairs Advisory Board provides a forum for residents to voice concerns and issues relating to the over age 50 population, assists in developing educational programs for elders, and makes recommendations to City Council.

ENVIRONMENTAL ADVISORY BOARD

Three vacancies. Must be a resident and a qualified elector of the City of Boca Raton.

Members of this board provide constructive advice and counsel to the City Council and city departments regarding environmental protection and conservation. Members shall be knowledgeable concerning environmental problems and concerned with the need to effect reasonable solutions thereto.

MARINE ADVISORY BOARD

One vacancy. Must be a resident and a qualified elector of the City of Boca Raton.

The position is for a professional engineer with experience in marine and coastal matters. The Marine Advisory Board makes recommendations to City Council regarding issues related to waterways within the City of Boca Raton.

NORTH FEDERAL HIGHWAY STEERING COMMITTEE

One vacancy. Must be a Small Scale Business Owner (not a property owner, 20 or fewer employees). The business must be located in the Master Plan area.

Members of this committee assist the City in the development of the North Federal Highway Master Plan.

Interviews will be conducted at the Monday, April 12, 2010 Workshop Meeting and at the Tuesday, April 13, 2010 Regular Meeting in the Council Chamber in City Hall, 201 West Palmetto Park Road. The Workshop Meeting will begin as soon as possible following the conclusion of the Community Redevelopment Agency Meeting that is scheduled to begin at 1:30pm. The Tuesday night meeting is scheduled to begin at 6:00pm or as soon thereafter as possible. Appointments will be considered at the Regular Meeting.
