NOTICE

Plans have been prepared to include bicycle and pedestrian improvements along St. Andrews Blvd. between Yamato Road and Glades Road. To view the improvements, the City has provided a link to the City's web site to view the plans. A shared use pathway, bicycle lanes, decorative paver entrance features, driveway restoration, tree relocations and irrigation maintenance and adjustments are incorporated in the construction drawings. If you do not have access to a computer, you can request a copy of the plans.

BACKGROUND

The Bicycle, Pedestrian, Greenways and Trails Master Plan was developed out of increasing concern for bicycle and pedestrian safety and consisted of recommendations from the Citizen's Pedestrian and Bikeway Advisory Board, the Parks and Recreation Board and City of Boca Raton staff. The adopted master plan identifies the construction of bicycle and pedestrian improvements along St. Andrews Blvd. as routes to Woodlands Park and Pinecrest School along with interconnecting bicycle and pedestrian routes. The City applied for and received a \$1,000,000 grant towards the construction of this project.

PLANS

Construction plans and typical cross sections are on display for public viewing at <http://www.ci-boca-raton.fl.us/> under the News and Information tab. Property owners adjacent to St. Andrews Blvd. are encouraged to view the plans. If you do not have access to a computer, you can request a copy of the plans. This is the opportunity for property owners to view the plans and post any questions you may have for the project. Staff will be responding to all questions posted on the web site. Construction is proposed this fiscal year, within the next three months.
