
**BOCA RATON PUBLIC LIBRARY – DOWNTOWN
PRESENTS “MARKS OVER TIME,” AN ART EXHIBIT BY TINA SALVESEN
NOVEMBER 12–DECEMBER 15, 2017**

(Boca Raton, FL) -- The Boca Raton Public Library is pleased to present a new art exhibit, “Marks Over Time,” by Tina Salvesen. Her artwork focuses on fine mark making using charcoal, pencil, ink, watercolor, pastels, paint and encaustic. Neil Schulhoff, Library Program Services, calls Salvesen’s work a “wonderful combination of sheer mastery of technique and joie de vivre of form.”

Tina Salvesen recently returned to her native Florida after living in the Northeast and Europe for many years. She attended Skidmore College, and received a bachelor’s degree in Art. She also holds an M.Ed. in Art Education from Temple University. Regarded as a master draftsman, she has won many awards in shows throughout the United States. She has exhibited worldwide, including shows in the Newark Museum, the New Jersey State Museum, State Museum of Pennsylvania, and Belgium and Spain.

Salvesen’s art reflects the “multi-dimensional world that vibrates around us.” In describing her *Knot* series, she says, “Life is like a cord, and along it you find a series of knots. The cord is life’s journey. The knots are the unique life lessons that challenge and transform each one of us along one’s path.” Of her *Nature* series, Salvesen notes, “The leaves and plants mirror the human experience of rebirth.”

“Marks Over Time” will run from November 12–December 15, 2017, at the Downtown Library, an Art in Public Places venue, at 400 NW 2nd Avenue. The exhibit is free and open to the public during regular library hours.
