NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City Council of the City of Boca Raton, Florida will hold public hearings on the following proposed ordinances and resolutions at a Regular Meeting on **Tuesday, November 14, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.**, or as soon thereafter as possible, at which time they will consider their adoption. The Regular Meeting will be held in the Auditorium of the City's 6500 Building located at 6500 N. Congress Avenue. All interested citizens are invited to participate in the meeting and be heard on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, with respect to the ordinances and resolutions.

Ordinance No. 5678

An ordinance of the City of Boca Raton amending Chapter 2, "Administration," Article II, "City Council," Section 2-27, "Rules of Procedure", Code of Ordinances, to reduce the minimum speaking time allotted to a person wishing to address the Council from five (5) minutes to three (3) minutes; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing for codification; providing an effective date

Ordinance No. 5679

An ordinance of the City of Boca Raton amending Chapter 5, "Animals," Article I, Code of Ordinances, by creating Section 5-4, "Nuisance-causing wildlife feeding prohibited," to prohibit the feeding of pigeons, ducks, and other wildlife in ways that result in accumulation of waste, vermin attraction, public disruption, property damage, unpleasant odors, or health and environmental risks; amending Chapter 9, "Miscellaneous Offenses," Article IV, Section 9-60, "Supplemental Code Enforcement Procedures," Code of Ordinances, to authorize the enforcement of such prohibition through the issuance of direct citations and remove a duplicative direct citation reference to Section 7-26, "Codes-Adopted"; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing for codification; providing an effective date (AM-23-13)

Resolution No. 118-2023

A resolution of the City of Boca Raton amending the "Schedule of Minimum Civil Penalties for violations enforced pursuant to Section 9-60, Code of Ordinances" (Resolution No. 163-2018, as amended by Resolution No. 68-2022) to provide for a civil penalty for violations of Section 5-4 (nuisance-causing and wildlife feeding prohibited), Section 9-110 (prohibition of the sale or distribution of polystyrene foam products on City property), Section 9-111 (prohibition of balloons and confetti in outdoor areas on City Property), Section 10-64(1) (time of day of construction activity), and Section 14-11 (bulk and vegetative waste collection time/placement); and update a cross reference to the Code of Ordinances; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing an effective date

Resolution No. 119-2023

A resolution of the City of Boca Raton, pursuant to Section 166.0451, Florida Statutes, determining whether any real property held in fee simple title by the City or any dependent special district within its boundaries is appropriate for potential use as affordable housing, and including an inventory list of such property; providing for severability; providing for repealer; providing an effective date
